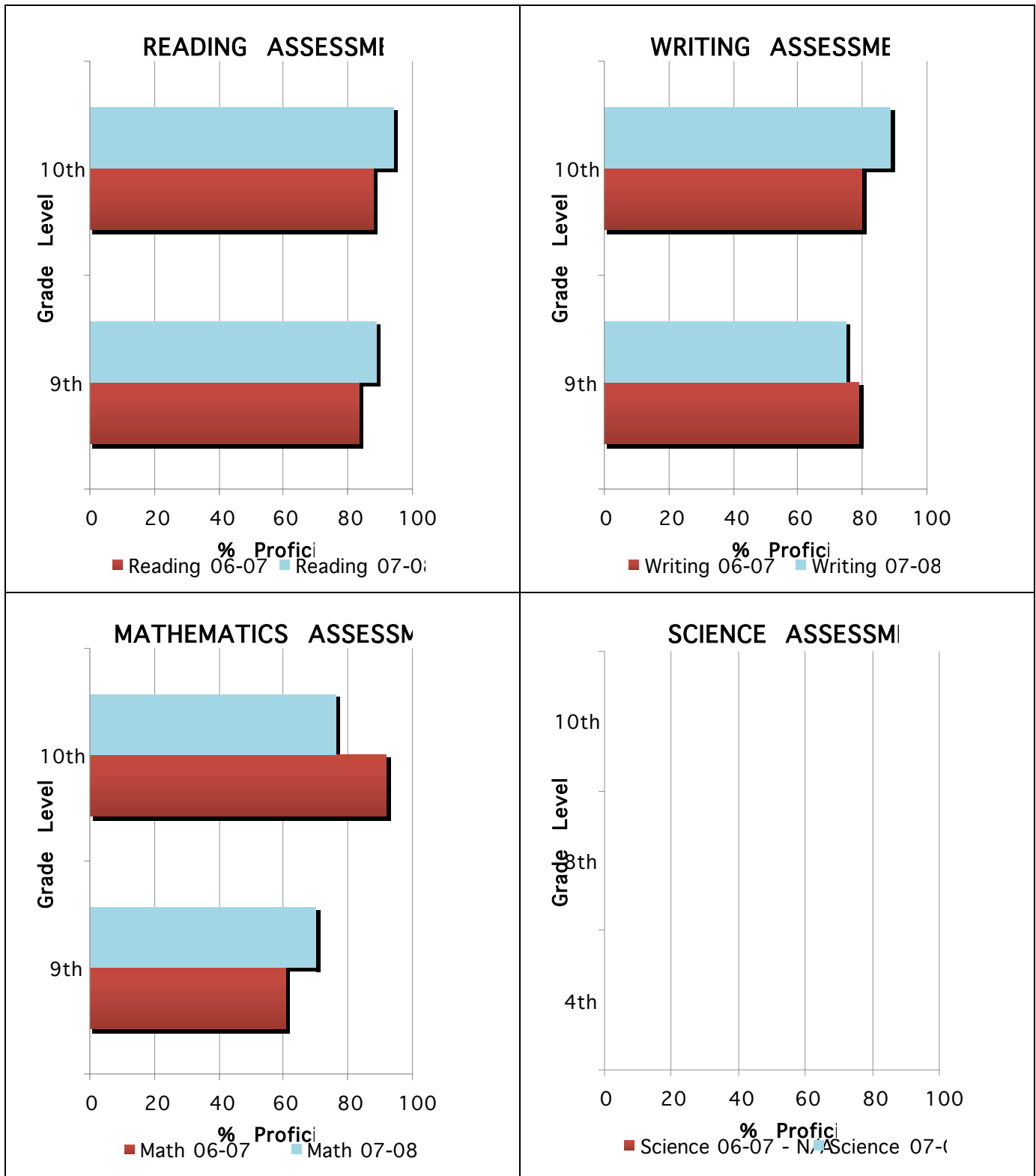

Other Required Report Card Elements:

Craig High School has been fully accredited by the Northwest Association of Accredited School since 1980.

Craig High School made AYP.

No school in the Craig City School District has been identified as persistently dangerous.

Student transfers accounted for 24.3% of enrollment change.

Number and Percentage of Students Passing High School Graduation Qualifying Exam:  
10<sup>th</sup> grade – 12 students (66.66% of the 18 test takers) passed all sections on first attempt.  
12<sup>th</sup> grade – 100% of graduating seniors passed the HSGQE.

Each year students and parents are encouraged to fill out satisfaction surveys. Surveys were returned by 100% of both students and parents. Students provided comments on 12 surveys; 30 parents provided comments; and 10 community members provided comments.

The average number of volunteer hours per week spent in school was 10 hours.

State averages for Science will be available from the State in mid-September.
