



# Don't miss the opportunity to save money during the next school year!

Eligible Migrant Students qualify for free lunches, for three years, under Federal law.



Your child may qualify if the following guidelines are met:

**1. Your child *subsistence fished* or *commercial fished* with you (or another adult) outside the Craig city limits and stayed overnight (for any combination of seven nights).**

**OR**

**2. If you moved to Prince of Wales for a job in the *logging industry*, in the last three years.**
